

REAL LIFE

On 30th October, 1050 personnel were deployed in total in the camp of Wildflecken. 480 belong to the command posts Eurocorps and 210 to the French-German Brigade. 160 personnel are in charge of the smooth operation of the



information systems, while 200 others provide real-life support. 40 work in the kitchens and bars, under the orders of Lieutenant Lecomte. In order to enable the whole personnel to eat within a reasonable timeframe, three kitchens are being operated. They use the camp's infrastructural equipment and are reinforced by field kitchens. Each catering facility has a large dining room in which 350 people can sustain themselves. Two full meals are prepared everyday (lunch and dinner) and a large breakfast is served every morning.

Sargento Primero Amate is responsible for the Eurobar and a coffee point installed in building 12. The number of coffees served gives a fair idea of their activity: 2,800 cups were served between 18th and 27th October, even before the bulk of the exercising troops had arrived in Wildflecken! Here are also a few impressive figures concerning the same period:

Everyone could notice that neither quantity (as shown by the figures) nor quality are lacking in the served products. Let us just hope that the weighing machine back home will not also confirm this fact.
